Question:

1. What specific goals other than those related to the occupation, have you established for yourself?
2. What motivates you to put forth your best effort?
3. How do you determine or evaluate your success?
4. What qualities should a professional possess?
5. What accomplishments have given you the most satisfaction? Why?
6. In what kind of environment are you most comfortable?
7. How would you utilize your Cosmetology or Esthetics education?

Essay:

In at least 500 words or more typed, describe how you feel the salon industry, as a whole will benefit by your involvement in becoming a Cosmetologist or Esthetician? If selected, why would you be the best candidate to have the scholarship? Include as much personal experience as you can and explain what drives and motivates you and what you are passionate about.

Please be as specific as you can. Finalist will be selected by their applications and essay entries.

- ***In order to be eligible to accept the scholarship if you are chosen as the winner, you must meet the admission requirements of the institute. It is not a requirement that you have to be enrolled to compete. If awarded the scholarship you are able to register any time that day. You must enroll by the summer 2011 class.***

Aveda Institute Las Vegas / Scholarship Competition 2010

- Cosmetology Contest is based on the model that has the best-finished, total look (hair style, makeup, and clothing) and the Esthetics Contest is judged by the best makeup application.
- Winners will be awarded a full Cosmetology or full Esthetics scholarship (provided eligibility requirements are met).
- To be eligible to compete you must be in your last year of high school, GED, or a graduate from high school.
- All models must be 13 years or older and cannot be men or children.
- Contestants must complete both the essay and question section of the application and email it to casalavedavegas@aol.com with subject label as scholarship program or send it to Aveda Institute Las Vegas 4856 S. Eastern Ave. Las Vegas NV 89119. No later than **October 16, 2010 by 5:00 PM.**
- Those selected to compete will be contacted.
- Esthetics contestants must have their model wear all black dress with their hair pulled away from their face. Contestants are judged on the best evening glamour look of the model's makeup.
- When Cosmetology and Esthetician models arrive, there will be a before picture taken that will be given to the judges that evening so they can judge the best before and after look.
- No cutting or chemical services will be performed on the models the day of the competition, you will be responsible for the overall style of the models (hair, makeup, and clothing), and you **will not** be judged on the haircut or color of your model's hair. (Cosmetology Contest only). Models must be in all black.
- The day of the competition you will be given **5 hours** to complete the models hair makeup, nails, clothing, you are required to bring all of your own supplies and products to perform these tasks.
- Contestants must work alone on their model
- Contestants with any prior industry training or schooling are not eligible to participate
- It is not a requirement to enroll prior to the competition, if chosen as a winner you may register after that evening.
- For each program we must have a minimum number of contestants to have the scholarship competition.
